Payment schedule for the Battle of Lake Erie:

\$750 nominating fee - postmarked by March 15 \$1,000 sustaining fee - postmarked by April 15 \$1,500 entry fee - due on race night, July 21

Racing conditions – The Battle of Lake Erie will be limited to the eight* (8) highest money winning horses in 2011/2012 combined amongst those that enter as of the entry date for the race (Wed., July 18, by 9 a.m. Eastern time). USTA records (including currency conversions) will be accepted as official.

In the event of more than 8 entries, a horse that is declared for the Battle of Lake Erie but does not draw in due to the above condition will have its nominating and sustaining fee returned and will not be liable for an entry fee as long as it is qualified to race.

If fewer than 12 horses nominate or sustain, or fewer than 7 horses enter the Battle of Lake Erie, Northfield Park reserves the right to cancel the event and return all fees.

All horses must meet Northfield's current qualifying standards at time of entry and have a current negative Coggins test (within one year of date of race).

*No Owner or Trainer may race more than two horses in the Battle.
